### Prevention and Aftercare Services

South Asian Network offers the following services to LA County residing families with children under the age of 18 who are at risk of abuse, neglect, poverty, or limited access to resources and support.

- Educational workshops on abuse prevention, how to stay positive and communicate, and the pathway to a child's healthy development
- · Financial literacy training
- ESL/Citizenship classes
- Assistance in accessing resources (ie. food, shelter, clothing, toys, etc.)
- Public benefit applications (ie. CalFresh, Medi-cal)
- Outreach events and town halls to strengthen community support systems



#### **DOMESTIC VIOLENCE**

#### **A FEW SIGNS:**

Interrogation about whereabouts and who you're speaking to / not being able to speak to friends and family

Being cyber-bullied and stalked when using social media / not being allowed to use it at all

Being insulted or verbally humiliated in private and/or public

Facing threats, manipulation, gaslighting, grooming, etc

Being threatened with deportation, abandonment, or separation from children and family

Having no control of or access to finances

Being forced to watch or engage in any sexual0 acts against your will


